Dear Senator Leahy:

In follow-up to the **original** Complaint I submitted for filing on July 14, 2008, enclosed please find copies of the following documents recently submitted for filing for the Legislature/Congress' records:

1. Plaintiff's Response to Court's Order Dated August 5, 2008 (Docket No. 162) – In the U.S. District Court of Mississippi Southern District (Jackson); Case No. 3:07-cv-00099TSL LRA (Submitted for filing on August 14, 2008);
2. Correspondence of August 15, 2008, to Samuel Givens (Clerk of Court of Appeals) – In the Kentucky Court of Appeals Case Nos. 2008-CA-000242-OA and 2008-CA-000379-OA; and
3. Plaintiff's Response to Defendants' Re-Notice of Motion for Dismissal for Failure to Comply With Order of Court; and Notice of Filing of Official Complaint With The United States Legislature/United States Congress – In the Circuit Court of Kenton County, Kentucky; Case No. 06-CI-03270 (**IT'S IMPORTANT TO NOTE:** I have included the Docket Sheet [as an Exhibit] for this case so that you will see just how corrupt this Court is. Opposing parties and/or their counsel are not required to file pleadings which contain facts, evidence and legal conclusions to rebut that presented by me. They were repeatedly allowed to come before the Court with "mere *verbal* argument." This is the case where opposing

counsel worked with the assigned Judge at the same law firm before the Judge took the bench).

While I have not heard anything from your office or those who have received a “**copy**” of the **Official** Complaint submitted for filing with the United States Legislature/Congress, I am now moving forward to share documents provided you and/or Legislature/Congress to select groups – exposing what African-Americans have long been aware is taking place – the “**Racial/Discriminatory** Injustices in the Judicial/Government System.” Considering my personal experience and/or encounters and the attacks leveled against me, I am trying to determine just how far such **corruption** is rooted (whether the Legislature/Congress has a role in the way the Courts as well as government agencies have acted). I know that if one were to “*google*” my name, it is obvious that the government has gone to great lengths to aid in the blacklisting of my name with knowledge of the corrupt practices it has engaged in to see that my life is destroyed and clearly efforts to see that it is difficult for me to obtain employment – clearly in violation of my Constitutional Rights (affecting pursuit of happiness, justice, etc.)

I sincerely hope you as well as the Legislature/Congress take my concerns very seriously and the necessary Investigations, Hearings and Findings are rendered to correct the legal wrongs and violations reported.
